

Outstanding Paper award(s) for the Journal of the Nevada Water Resources Association

In honor of Dr. Michael Rosen, whose commitment and dedication to Nevada Water Resources Association (NWRA) was instrumental in maintaining the high quality and persistence of the Journal of the Nevada Water Resources Association (JNWRA), NWRA has established an award for an Outstanding Paper associated with annual editions of the journal. NWRA has also established an award for an Outstanding Student Paper.

The following criteria will apply for both awards:

- The submitted paper must be published in an issue of the JNWRA
- The paper must be relevant to members of Nevada Water Resources Association
- A maximum of one award for each (Michael Rosen Outstanding Paper and Outstanding Student Paper) will be given out annually (i.e., if there is more than one edition in a year, the awards will be given out over all issues of that year)
- The value of each award is \$100.
- All manuscripts that are submitted in the calendar year will be eligible.
- Nevada Water Resources Association reserves the right to forgo an award if funds or quality of submitted papers are not available
- The winners of each award will be announced during the NWRA Annual Conference

- Additional criteria for the Outstanding Student Paper Award:
 - The paper needs to be relevant to work the student performed while a student (i.e., students who have graduated and are now professionals are still eligible if the work the paper describes was done while they were a student)

Judging for both awards will be as follows:

- Peer reviewers of each submitted paper will be requested to vote (yes/no) on the applicability of the paper for the “Michael Rosen Outstanding Paper Award” or “Outstanding Student Paper Award”
- The paper that receives the most votes for the award will receive it
- In the event that there is a tie, the Technical Journal Editor will review the papers that tied for the award and determine the winner
