

## **Selection Criteria for Nevada Water Resources Association Lifetime Achievement Award**

Previous NWRA Board of Directors has had discussions on the selection of Lifetime Achievement Award Recipients. In 2008 there was significant discussion by the Board on what the criteria selection should be and resulted in the informal adoption of the following selection criteria:

- Candidates must have contributed a significant portion of their career to Nevada's water resources.
- Preferred that the candidate was either a member of **NWRA** during their career, or
- Participated in **NWRA** events, but it is not a requirement.
- Candidates may be retired from a water resources career and can be working in another position/occupation after they retire from a lifetime career in water resources.
- This award is generally bestowed on a deserving recipient antemortem (before death). However, a posthumous (after death) award may be granted to a deserving recipient at the discretion of the NWRA Board of Directors.
- Candidate nominations are to be submitted by the posted deadline and can be submitted by anyone.

The selection of the recipient is determined by the NWRA Board of Directors through an anonymous voting process managed by the Executive Consultant. To keep the announcement confidential until the Annual Conference, the portion of the Board Meeting where the recipient is determined is OFF the record and NOT included in the meeting minutes.
